The second UHC Conference is an interdisciplinary platform that brings together national and county governments and other key stakeholders to discuss, share and learn of innovative and transformative solutions to halt and reverse the raging non-communicable diseases epidemic.

Objectives



- 1. To have conference participants understand:
 - the NCD challenge in Kenya as well as the national strategy on NCDs.
 - Share best practices and case studies on NCD control (HSS approaches, prevention, promotion and wellness models, treatment access models, financing models)

Objectives



- 2. Discuss <u>multi-sector approaches</u> to address NCDs including;
 - The role of the private sector in accelerating treatment access
 - The role of consumer organisations in protecting consumers from harmful products,
 - * The role of governments and civil society.
- 3. Discuss the role of the <u>young people</u> in stopping the raging NCD epidemic through their meaningful engagement.

Conference outcomes



- Improved understanding of the status and challenges of non-communicable diseases in Kenya.
- 2. Increased knowledge and skills on health systems strengthening and non-communicable diseases.
- Recommendations on strategies for enhancing stakeholder contribution to the prevention and management of non-communicable diseases.
- 4. Consensus on a Commitment to Action statement for scaling up services in addressing non-communicable diseases and an Action Plan for joint advocacy.
- 5. Conference report to be presented to the stakeholders and UHC Steering Committee to support the implementation of Universal Health Coverage.
