

YFL provides skills, voice, connections, and support for youths to lead fulfilled and productive lives.

To equip and stimulate the potential of youths with career, professional, journalism and media skills, resources, and support to bring about positive change in their local communities.

YFL envisions a thriving local media and economies where youths are active participants through improved skills, connections, and engagement.







Our Approach

Our services (Kenya)

Youth Media

Recruit, train & retain Community Journalists (CJs) through media & journalism qualifications in every county in Kenya.

This enables them to produce and publish contents on Yfl.org, Mojatu.com, social media and other platforms and social media.

12 Community Journalists covering 12 counties.

Digital Inclusion

Recruit, train, equip, and support youths to gain ICT skills and to become Digital Inclusion Ambassadors (DIAs.

This equips them to counter digital skills gaps and earn from the digital economy by working in our and partner ICT centers and institutions.

7 ICT centers under development in 5 counties.

Environmental Action

Recruit, train, equip, and support youths to become Environment Ambassadors (EAs)

This enables them to work & earn from forestry (nurseries & tree planting), Biogas, agribusiness, and other environmental projects.

10,860 trees planted and 8 nurseries created in 7 counties



Our services (Somalia)

YFL College

YFL Technical and Vocational college established offering face-to-face, online and hybrid training programs targeting youths.

We offer computing, ICT, business, management digital & creative media, STEM, Health, Social Care, Arts and Hospitality courses.

186 participants & graduates in 2023 in 14 courses.

Incubation Centre

We offer comprehensive incubation program tailored to guide young entrepreneurs throughout their startup and growth journey.

A diverse network of experienced mentors from different industries nurture young talent to launch, grow, and thrive.

27 sessions & 11 businesses being supported in 2023.

- Our impact: Difficulties in measuring and reporting on and sustaining our true impact.




